

TFRMINOLOGY

Developed by Johnny's: New seed varieties, tools, and supplies introduced after careful years of work and evaluation by Johnny's traditional plant breeders or product experts.

Certified Organic: Seeds harvested from, or plant material grown, harvested, stored, and handled under the guidelines and laws required by the USDA National Organic Program (NOP) and the Code of Federal Regulations.

Certified Naturally Grown: Verified to meet high standards for ecological production through a peer-review process. All standards are detailed at Naturallygrown.org.

Hybrid (F1): The offspring of a cross between two genetically distinct parent lines. Hybrid varieties are selected for traits such as improved flavor, disease resistance, fruit quality, yield, and climate adaptability. An (F1) hybrid refers to first filial or first-generation offspring of the cross. Seed saved from an F1 hybrid will not produce plants with characteristics equivalent to the F1 hybrid.

Open Pollinated (OP): Non-hybrid variety that can reproduce itself in kind, with relatively stable traits from one generation to the next. Seeds saved from open-pollinated varieties produce plants very similar to their parents.

Heirloom: Open-pollinated variety whose seed lines have been maintained by gardeners and farmers over generations, prized for traits such as appearance, fragrance, and flavor.

Conventional: Not certified organic.

Pelleted: Covered with a coating that improves the shape, size, and uniformity of raw seeds for more accurate sowing by hand and machine.

Treated: Fungicidal coating that protects seeds from soilborne pests or pathogens during seeding and germination. Our treated seeds are neonicotinoid-free. All treated products have a "T" at the end of the part number.

Untreated: Seeds that have no chemical treatments. All seeds offered by Johnny's are untreated unless otherwise noted.
