Sunflowers: Pollenless, Single-Stem <i>Helianthus annuus</i>	7-14 days at 70-75°F (21-24°C)	Direct seed (recommended): After last frost, sow ½" deep. Transplant: Sow into 72 to 50-cell flats 2-3 weeks prior to planting out. Plants dislike root disturbance, but sowing indoors and then transplanting the first crop outdoors can be a successful way to get first-early sunflowers. Do not pinch plants. Pinched single-stem sunflowers will produce low-quality blooms or no blooms at all. Succession-sow every 1-2 weeks and/or plant multiple varieties with varied days to maturity for continuous harvest. Sunflowers: Branching <i>Helianthus annuus</i>	7-14 days at 70-75°F (21-24°C)	Direct seed (recommended): After last frost, sow ½" deep. Transplant: Sow into 72 to 50-cell flats 2-3 weeks prior to planting out. Plants dislike root disturbance but sowing indoors and then transplanting the first crop outdoors can be a successful way to get first-early sunflowers. Pinching branching varieties is recommended to encourage branching and longer stems. Succession-sow every 2-3 weeks and/or plant multiple varieties for continued harvest.
